DEFINITION: Blunt Wrap: Any tobacco product manufactured or packaged as a wrap or as a hollow tube made wholly or in part from tobacco that is designed or intended to be filled by the consumer with loose tobacco or other fillers.

REGULATORY LANGUAGE: No person or entity shall sell or distribute blunt wraps in [city/town].

NOTE: In 2011, Boston prevailed in a lawsuit brought by blunt wrap makers (RYO Cigar Association, Inc. and New Image Global, Inc. v. Boston Public Health Commission). *Webster bans “blunt wrappers” under a paraphernalia definition. 6/21/19
