Sanitary Inspector Board of Health

A position is open for a candidate with experience in the physical, biological and social sciences, supplemented by specialization in the field of sanitary sciences and technology. Is qualified to carry out instructional and inspection duties, enforce the laws in the field of environmental sanitation and carry out any other appropriate duties assigned by the Executive Director of the Board of Health. This position is part of the City of Taunton Management Association (COTMA).

Essential Functions:

- Conducts a variety of inspections and tests including but not limited to the following areas: witnessing soil examinations and percolation tests, various phases of the installation of subsurface sewerage disposal systems, housing, vector control, food establishments, swimming pools, camps, ice skating rinks, solid waste, noise and air pollution control, massage establishments, general nuisance issues, etc.
- Pursues legal action when appropriate and necessary to enforce State Sanitary Code.
- Reviews plans for Disposal Works Construction Permits, building permits, food establishments, swimming pools, etc. and ensures compliance with state and local health codes.
- Investigates a variety of health related complaints and works towards compliance with state and local health codes.

Qualifications, Experience and Training

Bachelor's Degree required from a college or university of recognized standing, specializing in environmental health, public health, or biological sciences. Knowledge of laws, rules, and regulations pertaining to public and environmental health required with the ability to enforce such regulations. Skills in reviewing construction plans and in making necessary inspections. Ability to work well with others, manage multiple tasks at once, be objective, fair and analytical in judging violations and determining compliance with applicable codes.
