WHAT IS AN ASSESSMENT?

ASSESSMENT

the systematic collection of information to monitor the progress of something for the purpose of making decisions



Types of Assessments - Local Public Health

ENVIRONMENTAL SCAN

CAN BE UTILIZED TO COLLECT DATA TO INFORM HEALTH PROGRAMS AND POLICIES UNIQUELY TAILORED TO THE NEEDS OF COMMUNITIES



ASSESSMENT TIME HORIZONS

Specified Period of Time

- Static
- Snapshot in time

Example: Assessment of your department's 2022

Food Inspection reports.

Ongoing Monitoring & Evaluation

- Continuous
- Could be over multiple weeks, months, or years

Example: Bi-annual assessment of the impact of a

Maternal & Child Health program.



WHY CONDUCT AN ASSESSMENT?

What impact, if any, is occurring?

Advocacy to community leadership & policy makers

Communication to the public, community partners, & other departments

Health Department
Accreditation (PHAB)

Ongoing management and workforce decision making

Quality Improvement

It is not meant to be daunting


An assessment can be as complicated as you want it to be

- The North Star is how to ensure that the data you collect is strong
 - "Garbage in, garbage out."

 There are several ways to begin/plan out how to conduct an assessment (ex. Logic Model)


LOGIC MODELS

- Are a visual way to illustrate the resources or inputs required to implement a program, the activities and outputs of a program, and the desired program outcomes (short-term, long-term).
- Effective tools to assist in program planning, implementation, management, evaluation, and reporting.
- Help define a program's intended impact and goals; the sequence of intended effects; which activities are to produce which effect; and where to focus outcome and process evaluations.



LOGIC MODEL **EXAMPLE:** REDUCING YOUTH TOBACCO
