This position is a public-facing position so customer service, and working with the public professionally and positively, is paramount. Job duties primarily include performing inspections in accordance with state and local public health laws and regulations, specifically for housing, food establishments, tobacco permit holders, rubbish haulers, swimming pools, summer camps, nuisances, body art, animal housing, and other evolving aspects of Public Health. Duties include investigating complaints, conducting various types of site inspections, and evaluation of the issues involved. Prepares related reports and records. Verbal and written communication is necessary.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in Environmental Health, Public Health, Environmental Science, Health Sciences, Biology or other related field and three or more years of related experience, or any equivalent combination of education and experience. **Must possess a valid driver's license and have strong writing skills. Ability to pass a CORI is required.**
