In all above instances, the smoking bar exemption found in the state law has been removed, banning smoking in “smoking bars. \* = language bans smoking bars. + = grandfathered one

Ban on “smoking” in smoking bars: 132 (32 cities in bold) – 50.1% of state’s population (3,500,735) lives in listed municipalities.

Ban on smoking bars: 18 (2 cities in bold) – 5.9% of state’s population (415,034) lives in listed municipalities.
