The position is responsible for administering state and local health and environmental codes, laws, and policies, including regulations from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, as well as Board of Health policies and other state and local public health regulations.

Successful candidate must have:

- ➤ Knowledge of state sanitary codes, including food sanitation, sub surface sewage, septic, and all other Commonwealth Health and Environmental laws and codes; knowledge of engineering concepts in relation to wastewater; knowledge of related federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations.
- Ability to conduct field inspections; ability to manage and supervise employees effectively; ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing; ability to maintain good public relations and effective collaborative working relationships with Town departments, department heads, fellow employees, officials, and the general public; ability to meet deadlines; ability to work independently and exercise independent judgment.
