- Prepares order letters seeking enforcement of violations. Prepares documents in support of public health hearings and department enforcement actions, hearings, legal actions as well as presentation of public health rationale for enforcement in court.
- o Act as a liaison and represents Department on committees or at meetings
- Attends educational meetings, seminars and training programs necessary to remain current with new regulations and policies; participates in professional organizations.

Qualified candidates must have a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in Biology, Environmental Science, Public or Environmental Health or related field, at least one year of experience, or any equivalent combination of education and experience in public or environmental health
