Job Posting – Public Health Nurse

Reporting to the Director of Public Health, the Public Health Nurse is responsible for carrying out public health nursing functions for the Nashoba Associated Boards of Health district, serving 16 communities. Essential functions include, but are not limited to:

- Conducts Communicable Disease Investigation reporting, surveillance and follow-up.
- Provides individual and community education to promote health and wellness.
- Provides immunizations to community members via clinics, home visits and/or other organized local events.
- Addresses disease prevention, chronic disease management and harm reduction through ongoing individual and community assessments and targeted teaching.

Minimum qualifications include a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing, current licensure by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as a Registered Nurse, current certification in CPR, a valid driver's license, and a minimum of 3 years relevant experience. Experience in community nursing and health education, along with a knowledge of public health is preferred.
